Anniversary of Americans With Disabilities Act




On July 26, 1990, then-President George H.W. Bush signed into law the Americans with Disabilities Act, which prohibits discrimination against people with disabilities in employment, transportation, public accommodations, commercial facilities, telecommunications, and state and local government services. The Americans with Disabilities Act is the most sweeping disability rights legislation in history, for the first time bringing full legal citizenship to Americans with disabilities.




