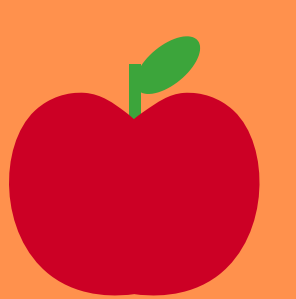

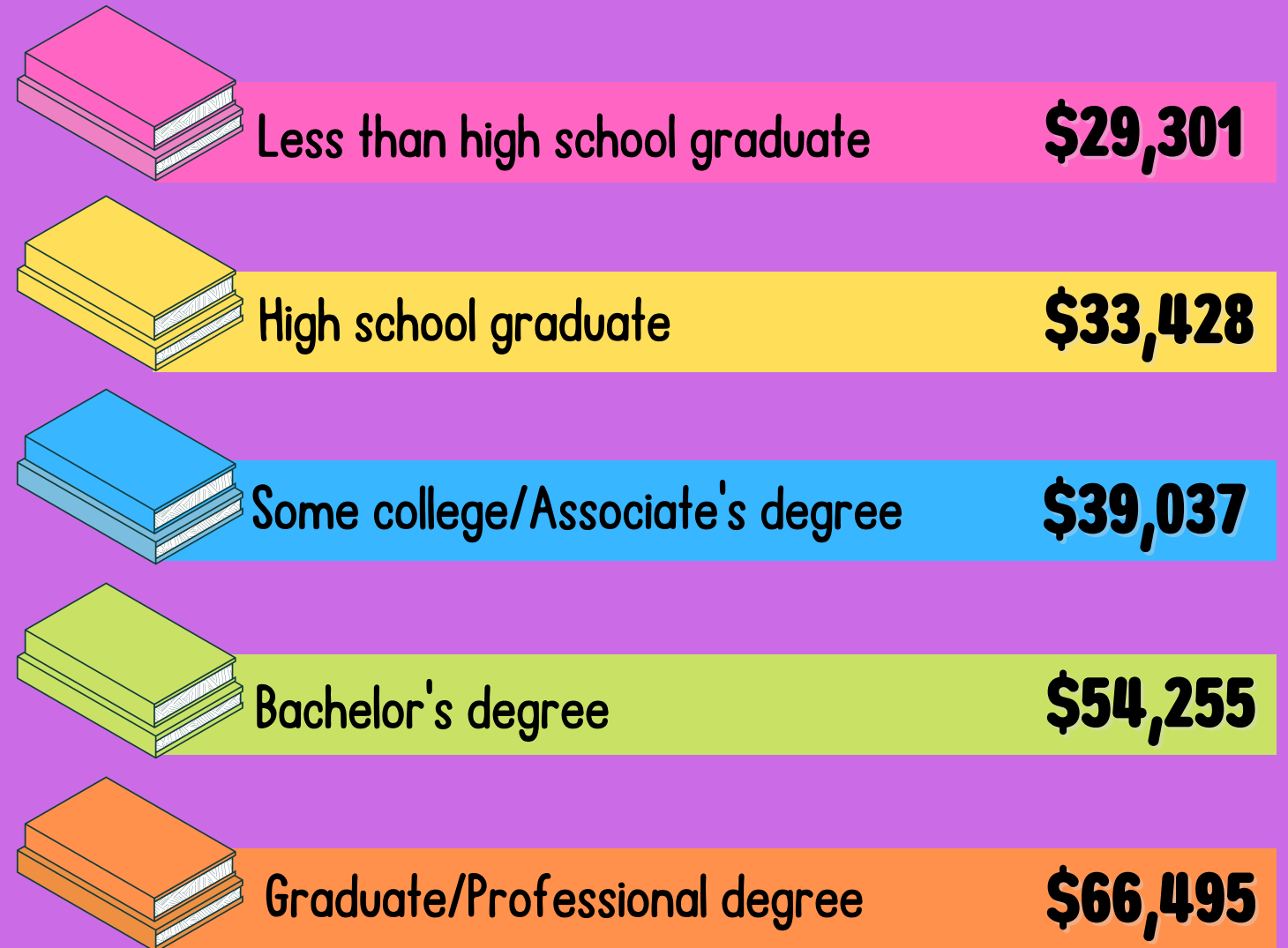

## Median Earnings by Educational Attainment



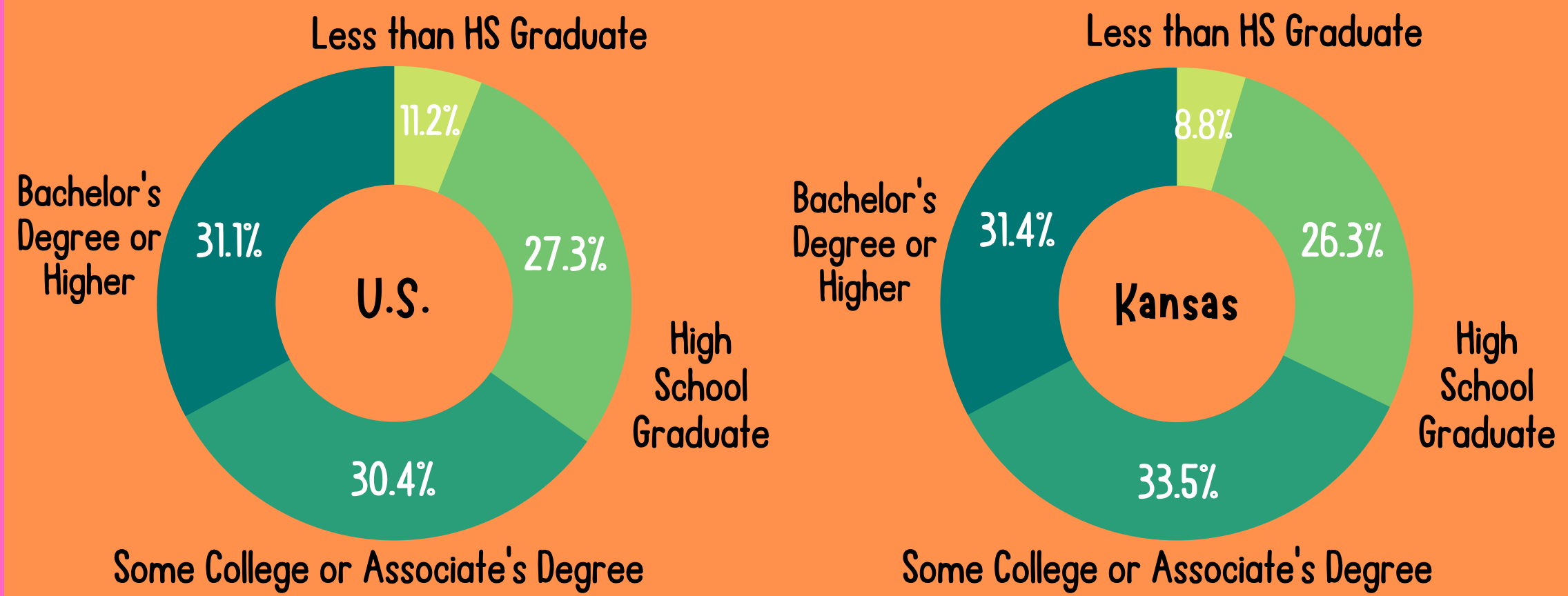

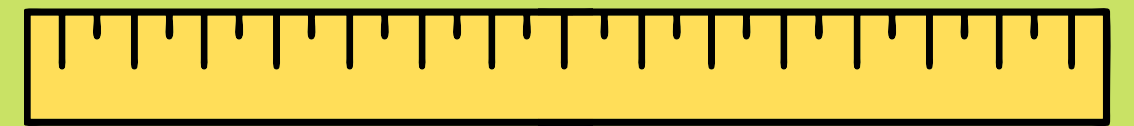
